

***Mijas Masters Competitions******at MIJAS LAWN BOWLS CLUB******Saturday 5th thru Sunday 13th February***

Conditions of Play will be mainly be in accordance with Crystal Mark World Bowls Rules and this Call notice. The controlling body for Mijas LBC (Ian Patterson) will make the draw on Friday 28th January 2022. These conditions of play will be displayed/available to umpires, entrants at MLBC during the event.

A.1.3.1 Pairs & Triples Open Competitions. Entries close noon Thursday 27th January

A.1.3.2 Triples will start Saturday 5th February, continuing 6th and 7th to quarter finals. Pairs will commence on 8th February, continuing 9th & 10th. The schedule of play for Saturday 12th and Sunday 13th February will be decided after completion of play on the 10th February. All first session games will commence no later than 10.30 each day.

A.1.3.4 **Entry fee €8/player/discipline for** players Federated in Spain or Internationally.

A.1.3.5 Each Competition will be played as a knock out and teams maybe required to play 2 games in a single day.

A.1.3.6 Games will be played over 18 ends with 3 bowl triples and 4 bowl pairs. Skips only will be permitted 6 visits to the head & staying at head is counted as a visit.

A.1.3.7 2 trial ends will be played prior to each game using all bowls in play.

A.1.3.8 Flat soled shoes and whites or club colours should be worn.

**A.1.4 Games will be played in line with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls Sport of Bowls.**

A.1.4.1 Competition forms part of FAB Malaga Calendar and stamps on bowls will comply with FAB Malaga requirements.

A.1.4.2 Games will be considered complete if they have to be stopped after completing a minimum of 14 ends due to weather etc. Games having completed less than 14 ends will be replayed in full if play is abandoned for the day.

A.1.4.3 In the event of a burnt end the jack will be re-spotted on the T.

A.1.4.5 Players with hearing disability must provide their own devices or assistant.

A.1.4.6 Should a team/player have a bye and where they are to play a team who has already played on that day, a vacant rink will be made available (if possible) for a maximum of a 30 minute practice. Using a rink not pre-allocated for their next game.

A.1.4.7 Pre match warm up will not be allowed at Mijas LBC on the day of play other than specified in A1.3.7. or A.1.4.6 above.

A.1.4.8 A 20 minute grace period will be given, immediately after the scheduled start time of a game before player/team to report to the Competition desk & they will be given a further 10 minutes to be on the rink & ready to play. Failure to comply will result in disqualification unless a substitute is available and permitted under the conditions of play.

A.1.4.10 Substitutes will be permitted as long as the substitute has not played for any other team during the Competition. If a substitute joins a team after the first game has been played they will not be allowed to skip. Substitutes can be replaced by the original player at the start of any subsequent game or the substitute can continue playing as part of the team.

Substitutes who have already been eliminated from the specific discipline will however, be allowed in the case of player illness if no other substitute is available, but they can not skip and must complete the game in process only. The original player or another substitute found before the start of the next game.

A.1.4.11 Arrangements for dealing with slow play will be at the discretion of the Controlling body.

A.1.4.12 Only the Skips will be permitted to visit to the head and this will be limited to 6 visits during the game prior to delivery of their final bowl.

A.1.4.13 Smoking, Vaping and the consumption of alcohol will not be allowed on the rink. Smoking and Vaping will be restricted to a specified area as identified by MLBC. Alcohol maybe consumed in other open and inside areas at rink level.

A.1.4.14 Drug testing will not be conducted.

A.1.4.15 Code of conduct and disciplinary procedures. See A.1.4.16

A.1.4.16 The Controlling Bodies will be responsible for resolving all disputes and their decision will be final.

A.1.4.17 Prizes and awards will be presented to the Winners and Finalists in each discipline.
