



F.A.B. ACCIDENT PROCEDURE

In the unfortunate event of an accident happening to you, or at your Club, please follow these guidelines.

- 1. Call the Accident Care Centre immediately - 902 10 71 20 - it is open 24 hours.**
- 2. They will ask for details of the injured person, the injury and the location.**
 - **To activate any medical service you will be asked to provide: Personal data of the injured, and one of TIE/NIE /Passport and Federation Licence Card, depending on your Resident status**
 - **Data of the Club or Sports Entity in which the accident happened, if applicable.**
 - **Date and manner of occurrence of the accident.**
 - **Description of physical damage.**
- 3. They will organise an ambulance and doctor, arrange transportation to the nearest associated Health Centre / Hospital if necessary.**
- 4. IN CASE OF A LIFE THREATENING EMERGENCY:**

The injured person may receive emergency medical assistance at the Nearest Health Centre. In these cases Helvetia will take over of invoices arising from emergency assistance provided in the first 24 hours from the date of occurrence of the sports accident covered in the policy. Once the patient is passed emergency assistance the injured must be transferred to the Associated Centre / Doctor to continue treatment.
